The Treasure Island Demonstration Garden is an award-winning public garden that features hundreds of plants that flourish in Windsor. It is one of only 70 Plant Select program demonstration gardens in a five-state region.

The garden is open for public viewing from sunrise to sunset, and is located adjacent to Laku Lake Road, along the Poudre River Trail, south of Eastman Park. Roadside parking is available via the 7th Street entrance. Most of the garden is accessible with paved surfaces.

Garden volunteers are available to speak on particular subjects or to provide an overview of the garden. Tours are available as long as the weather permits. For more information, call the volunteers at 303-726-7634.
